## On the conditions of FCY banknote acceptance

Dear Sir/Madam,

This is to remind you that considering and adjusted to the changes in service related risks and in accordance with this Bank's effective Announcements dated 3 June, 2013, the Bank **will not accept contaminated, damaged or incomplete banknotes** of the currencies traded by the Bank, either **for conversion, exchange of denominations or payment.**

FCY banknotes are accepted on condition they are genuine and valid, and they do not display any contamination (chemical or biological, for instance, discoloration, stains, labels, numbers, designs, stamps, etc. caused by paints, chemicals, foodstuffs, writing instruments or detergents); they cannot be damaged or incomplete (torn, glued, with holes, torn corners, etc.) irrespective of the size or location of the contamination, damage or deficiency on the banknote.

The Bank will accept banknotes that are worn, creased or lost crispness due to natural tear and wear, but are otherwise complete and free of contamination and damage, provided their currency, denomination, validity and genuineness can be unambiguously established.

Contaminated, damaged or incomplete FCY banknotes not traded by this Bank may still be valuable. Please, contact our staff for further information.
